2) What or who do the following pronouns refer to? (4 x 2) 8 pts

- a) they = Bernard and his father or Bernard and Mr Walsh or the two men
- b) we = the two women or the two young women or the young woman and her friend
- c) we = Bernard and his father or Bernard and Mr Walsh
- d) she = Ursula or Bernard's aunt or Mr Walsh's sister

3) Are the following statements true (T) or false (F)? Justify by quoting from the text and indicate the lines. (3 x 2) 6 pts

- attribuer 2 points pour toute réponse complète (true or false + citation correcte)
- ne pas attribuer de point pour toute réponse true or false correcte mais sans citation
- ne pas attribuer de point pour toute réponse true or false correcte mais avec une citation inappropriée
- ne pas attribuer de point pour une citation seule (sans la réponse à true or false)

- a) F "We arranged this trip at rather short notice" (l.13)
ou "Last-minute bargain" (l. 14)
- b) F "it was the cheapest way to travel – to take this package" (l. 21-22)
ou "'Last-minute bargain. You don't get much choice, then, do you? But you save a lot.'" (l. 14-15)
- c) T "Is it a long time since you saw your sister?"
'It is that,' Mr Walsh said." (l. 24-25)

4) Focus on lines 16 to the end and pick out one sentence showing that (4 x 2) 8 pts

- a) Mr Walsh didn't take part in the organisation of the trip:
"I didn't know we were going to a hotel,' said Mr Walsh querulously. 'I thought we were staying at Ursula's place.'" (l. 16-17)

b) Mr Walsh doesn't really want to visit Ursula.

"It's her who wants to see me." (l. 27)
