- Match each cover with a year “1966 – 1985 – 1986 – 1987 – 1990 – 1993 - 1994 – 1999 – 2008 - 2013”



Students watch the video to identify the following parts of a magazine cover

- 1- cover image
- 2- masthead
- 3- cover lines/headlines
- 4- kicker in large font + explainer line in smaller font
- 5- bar code bottom left
- 6- date line + price
- 7- model credit possible
- 8- flashed and slashes (puffs) to advertise a promotion
