Each pupil will keep a logbook in which he will write the evolution of his/her Stanley's journey. Therefore, we ask you not to keep Stanley too long (10 days at most) and to send him to someone who will accept to play the game so that each pupil can get his/her Stanley back at the end of the project. We ask the person being in possession of Stanley on **February 22nd**, **2009**, to send him back to the pupil named above to the following address :
