***HELP! * section**

- **Main idea** : The poet considers what it feels like to be a married woman / The poet considers that friends don't need to speak to understand each other / The poet addresses his lover and focuses on his devotion / The poet suggests that friendship lasts longer than love / The poet suggests he is not blind and that his lover's beauty may not be perfect ...
- **Literary device** : : alliteration / imagery / metaphor / personification / simile / ...
- **Effect on the reader** : it helps the reader picture the poet's thoughts or feelings / it helps the reader connect to the description / it reinforces a certain feeling (softness, hardness, ...) / it helps us understand something we may not see clearly by referring to something we do understand / it augments the reader's experience / it helps the reader feel the poet's emotions / it contributes to the aural dimension of the poem ...
